Procedure in relation to simple possession offences

S 36(1) Police must refer simple possession offenders to assessment service

S 36(3) The referral operates as a stay of proceedings for the alleged offence

s 37(1) Assessment service must complete assessment expeditiously

s 37(2)(a) Service may request medical records, drug treatment records, criminal records etc

s 37(2)(c) Service may require medical examination

s 37(3) Service must terminate referral if person fails to attend, referral is inappropriate, does not admit allegations, etc and may terminate if person fails to comply

s38 Person undertakes treatment or rehabilitation (up to 6 months)

s39 Person must be released from custody for assessment or undertaking

s40 Prosecution for simple possession offence cannot proceed unless referral has been terminated by service

s40(2) Participation in an assessment or undertaking does not constitute an admission of guilt

s40(3) If referral is terminated, evidence obtained by a service is inadmissible in Court

s40(4) On expiry of undertaking, the person is immune from prosecution

s40A No unauthorised disclosure of confidential information \$10 000

Other Offences, Penalties

S 44 **Sentencing factors** to be considered by a Court are - nature of substance, quantity of substance, personal circumstances (ie. drug dependence), if sale etc. whether commercial motives, whether in school zone or prescribed area etc.

Time limits for summary offences in which proceedings may be commenced (s 52 Summary Procedure Act 1921 (SA))

- If expiation notice given, within 6 months of expiry of expiation period in notice
- If no expiation notice given, within 6 months of offence
- If offence not expiable, within 2 years of the date of the offence
- No time limits for indictable offences

Expiation Notices

S 45A **Simple cannabis offences (see Expiation of Offences Act 1996 (SA))**

- (2) Power to issue notice for simple offences (not to a child) - 28 days to pay
- (7) Failure to issue EXP does not invalidate prosecution
- (8) Simple offence means less than prescribed quantities, or smoking/consumption, or less than 1 plants, but not in a public place etc.
